



## Janine Owen Educational Support Fund 2017

**The Janine Owen Scholarship** provides a 3-year scholarship/grant for a student from a Ballarat public High School / Secondary College who is looking to continue higher education studies in the Bachelor of Commerce at the Federation University Ballarat:

Bachelor of Commerce  
Bachelor of Commerce (Accounting)  
Bachelor of Commerce (Applied Economics and Finance)  
Bachelor of Commerce (Business Law)  
Bachelor of Commerce/Bachelor of Management (Combined degree)

The aim of the Award is to reduce the barriers to higher education by providing the means to purchase resources required for study. Assisting a deserving student with the financial costs of attending University, which would otherwise be prohibitive.

The Scholarship, valued at \$5,500 and gifted at \$2,500 in the first year and \$1,500 in each of the subsequent two years, will be presented to the successful candidate at a time and place as agreed with the High School and a representative from the Scholarship Trust.

### **The Candidate**

Prospective students will demonstrate a passion and interest in Accounting, Economics or Business, and will be shortlisted by local High School / Secondary College staff on the basis of socio-economic need and/or lack of family support.

The student(s) will be interviewed by a representative of the Scholarship Trust, and a member of The Ballarat Foundation for the final determination.

### **Acquittal**

The selected candidate will provide an annual update in writing in September to The Ballarat Foundation, with photographs, for publication on The Ballarat Foundation website and newsletters.

### **Terms and Conditions**

The successful candidate will abide by the terms set out in the Janine Owen Scholarship Agreement. Should the candidate drop out, change or defer their course, then they are required to notify The Ballarat Foundation immediately and funds will be suspended pending further discussion.
